Further, incoming Grades 7 and 8 learners from all sectors of the society, including indigenous peoples, persons with disabilities, and other marginalized groups are encouraged to **submit their applications under the following NAS focus sports: aquatics, athletics, badminton, gymnastics, judo, table tennis, taekwondo,** and weightlifting.

The NASCENT SAS aims to provide the following to successful applicants:

- a. Free tuition;
- b. Free board and lodging at the NAS Dormitory in NAS Campus, New Clark City, Capas, Tarlac;
- c. Provision of quality secondary education;
- d. Access to specialized sports training in world-class facilities;
- e. A chance to represent the country and NAS in international competitions and exchange programs;

f. Monthly stipend; and

g. Scholarship grant for six (6) years subject to the student-athlete's sports and academic performance.

Kindly note, however, that release of scholarship grant is subject to the availability of funds.
