1. The Schools Division Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct a live-out training entitled, "**Problem-Based Learning For Science Teachers**" on February 15-18, 2022 at Science Laboratory of Occidental Mindoro National High School, Mamburao, Occidental Mindoro.
2. This activity aims to build/strengthen the capacity of participants in the domain of Problem-Based Learning (PBL) by:
 - a. developing their understanding of the different principles of PBL;
 - b. becoming acquainted with different PBL experiences and lessons;
 - c. simulating classroom situations where learners are made to experience:
 - i. autonomous/self-directed learning and work,

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- ii. complex problem-solving activities through integration of knowledge and skills from other disciplines,
 - iii. team work, and
 - iv. self and peer evaluation.
