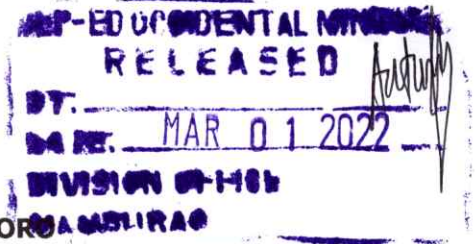

**DIVISIONS' TRAINING ON VEGGIESKWELA PROGRAM
IN SUPPORT TO GULAYAN SA PAARALAN PROGRAM**

TO: ALL SCHOOLS DIVISION SUPERINTENDENTS

1. DepEd MIMAROPA Region through the Education Support Services Division (ESSD) entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with the East-West Seed (EWS) Foundation, Inc. for the regionwide training on *VeggiEskwela* Program from March, 2022 onwards via online platform in support to the Department's mandate to strengthen the *Gulayan sa Paaralan* Program.
2. The program aims to support government's effort to explore all available strategies that would solidly sustain food productivity, availability, and sufficiency not only in schools but also to ensure food security at home of all public school learners regionwide
3. In view of this, all Schools Division Offices are enjoined to support the training program to be participated in by the Division EPP Education Supervisors, Division School-Based Feeding Program Coordinators, Division Youth Formation, Gulayan sa Paaralan (GPP) Coordinators, GPP school coordinators and select Supreme Pupil Government (SPG), Supreme Student Government (SSG) school leaders. Volunteer parents are also invited to attend on this training. The Youth Formation, GPP coordinators together with the Division EPP Education Program Supervisors are requested to take the lead on this partnership initiative.
4. A minimum of four (4) batches with twenty (20) participants per SDO are expected to be trained. The training shall be composed of an orientation and to be followed by a two (2) to three (3) hour webinar trainings, once a week for five (5) consecutive weeks. A Certificate of Completion shall be issued by the EWS upon completion of the scheduled trainings.
