Articles shall be ***in Word format, English or Filipino, strictly 1000-1300 words with photos***. There will be no limit as to the number of submitted articles, however, the SDOs are expected to submit those that have already passed their initial screening, and have already been checked and reviewed in terms of grammar and layout.

Previously submitted articles to PAU that fall under any topic cited above, shall also be considered for screening. Authors of chosen and submitted articles to PAS shall receive certificates, while those authors who will be finally included in the DepEd e-book shall receive tokens and certificates from PAS.

Submission of entries to the Regional Office shall start on Monday, March 7, 2022, until April 13, 2022. For fast submission, the PAU shall later provide a Google drive link to the SDOs.

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
