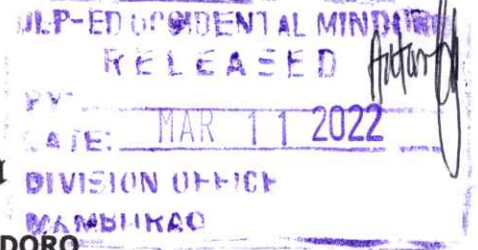

TRAINING OF TRAINERS ON FINANCIAL EDUCATION

1. In response to DepEd Order No. 022, s. 2021 entitled Financial Education Policy issued on June 3, 2021 which is pursuant to pertinent provisions of Republic Act (RA) No. 10922 or the Economic and Financial Literacy Act of 2016 and RA 10679 or the Youth Entrepreneurship Act of 2015, this Division shall conduct the **Division Training of Trainers on Financial Education** on March 15 to 16, 2022 at Mindoreños Hotel, Mamburao, Occidental Mindoro.
2. This activity aims to intensify the integration of Financial Education in the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum in various disciplines across grade levels and targets to enhance the financial literacy and financial capability of all learners, public school teachers, and DepEd personnel to make sound financial decisions that lead to financial health and financial inclusion (*paragraphs 2-3, DO No. 022, s. 2021*).
3. Participants whose names are listed in the attached documents are requested to bring with them a laptop, and extra masks. They are expected to arrive on March 16, 2022 with breakfast as the first meal and dinner as the last meal to be served on Day 2. Health protocols must be observed all the time to ensure safety of everyone.
4. Meals and board & lodging of participants and members of the program management team in a face-to-face mode shall be charged to HRD funds. Looc and Lubang participants may charge their meals and snacks to school MOOE. However, transportation expenses shall be charged to local funds and other sources of funds subject to the usual budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules.
5. Immediate dissemination of and appropriate action on this memorandum are earnestly desired.
