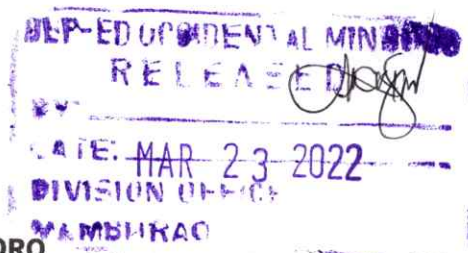

CONDUCT OF THE EARLY REGISTRATION FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2022-2023

1. In compliance with **DepEd Memorandum No. 17, s. 2022** titled **Conduct of the Early Registration for SY 2022-2023** dated March 21, 2022, this Division requires all public elementary and secondary schools to conduct the Early Registration for SY 2022-2023 from March 25 – April 30, 2022.
2. To ensure 100% compliance, all school heads must take note of the following:
 - All incoming Kindergarten, Grades 1, 7, 11 learners and transferees in all public elementary and secondary schools shall pre-register;
 - Grades 2-6, 8-10 and 12 learners are considered pre-registered and will not need to participate in the early registration;
 - Strictly follow the procedures and guidelines on the conduct of this activity as stipulated in DepEd Memorandum No. 17, s. 2022 and DepEd Order No. 3, s. 2018.
3. Private Schools are encouraged to conduct their respective early registration activities on the same timeframe.

CONDUCT OF THE EARLY REGISTRATION

TO :

The following information is being provided to you for your information and guidance in the conduct of the early registration process. This information is being provided to you as a member of the staff of the Division of Government Services.

1. The purpose of the early registration process is to provide a public hearing for the proposed project and to provide an opportunity for the public to comment on the project.

2. To ensure that the process is conducted in a fair and equitable manner, the following guidelines should be followed:
- All interested parties should be given an opportunity to comment on the project.
 - The project should be described in detail and the potential impacts should be explained.
 - The project should be open to public comment for a period of at least 30 days.
 - The project should be open to public comment for a period of at least 30 days.

4. Further, School Heads using LIS School Head Account are expected to encode/update daily the school's data on early registration thru the Learners Information System (LIS) while the SGOD - Planning and Research Section personnel shall monitor the on-time online submission.

CONDUCT OF THE EARLY REGISTRATION FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2022-2023

1. In preparation for the incoming class opening, the Department of Education (DepEd) announces that the Early Registration for School Year (SY) 2022-2023 shall be conducted **from March 25 to April 30, 2022**, nationwide.
2. As stipulated in DepEd Order (DO) No. 03, s. 2018 or the **Basic Education Enrollment Policy**, all incoming Kindergarten, Grades 1, 7, and 11 learners in all public elementary and secondary schools shall pre-register to allow the Department to make necessary preparations and adjustment of plans for the incoming school year. Grades 2-6, 8-10, and 12 are considered pre-registered and will not need to participate in the early registration. Private schools are encouraged to conduct their respective early registration activities on the same timeframe.
3. Daily updating or encoding in the Early Registration facility in the Learner Information System (LIS) shall be done by every school using the school head or school administrator account. Schools shall utilize the Modified Basic Education Enrollment Form (electronic or printed copies) to ensure that the necessary information in registering incoming Kindergarten, Grades 1, 7, and 11 learners and other data such as preferred learning modality are obtained properly.
4. Schools may also encode in the Early Registration facility the prospective enrollees for other grade levels (e.g., Grades 2-6, 8-10, and 12) based on the previous school enrollment to get the overall picture of the expected enrollees for the next enrollment.
5. In the context of the prevailing COVID-19 public health emergency, the conduct of the early registration shall be done remotely in areas under Alert Levels 3 to 5. In-person registration through parents or guardians may be allowed in areas under Alert Levels 1-2 provided physical distancing and health and safety protocols are strictly observed.
6. School authorities of public and private schools are mandated to strictly implement the kindergarten cut-off age under DO 020, s. 2018, **Amendment to DepEd Order No. 47, s. 2016**.
