- Per DepEd Order No. 17, s. 2022 titled "Guidelines on the Progressive Expansion of Face to Face Classes", Joint Memorandum Circular No. 001, s. 2022 dated April 6, 2022 with the subject "Revised Operational Guidelines on the Progressive Expansion of Face to Face Learning Modality", DepEd Memorandum No. 30, s. 2022 titled "Dissemination of the Revised School Safety Assessment Tool for the Progressive Expansion of the Face to Face Classes", and anchored on one of the Agenda under Executive Order No. 166 titled "Adopting the Ten-Point Policy Agenda to Accelerate and Sustain Economic Recovery from the COVID-19 Pandemic, and Directing a Whole-of-Government Approach to Align all Economic Recovery Programs and Measures of the National Government", i.e. "4. Resume Face-to-Face Learning. Each school shall bring the results of the Revised SSAT and all other documents requirements for the implementation of F2F classes.
