

SUBJECT: **TRAINING-WORKSHOP ON ESTABLISHING SEX-

DEVELOPMENT**

DATE: **April 7, 2022**

Pursuant to Section 36 (C) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9710, the Magna Carta of Women (MCW), all government agencies "shall develop and maintain a GAD database containing gender statistics and sex-disaggregated data that have been systematically gathered, regularly updated, and subjected to gender analysis for planning, programming, and policy formulation."

In addition, under PCW Memorandum Circular No. 2014-05 dated November 28, 2014, "all government agencies are mandated to implement Section 36 (C) of RA No. 9710 and generate timely and accurate sex-disaggregated data in support of the MCW indicators. Such data shall be stored and maintained in the agency's GAD database or similar system, updated as needed, and used in their policy and program development to address gender issues in their respective sectors, particularly in the preparation of their annual GAD plans and budgets and accomplishment reports."

In line with the foregoing issuances, DepEd MIMAROPA Region through the Gender and Development Focal Point System shall conduct a Training-Workshop on Establishing Sex-disaggregated Data (SDD) Database for Gender and Development on **April 20, 2022 at 9:00 AM-5:00 PM** via **MS Teams**.
