2022 SEARCH FOR ULIRANG GURO AT PAMBANSANG ULIRANG GURO OF MANILA TEACHERS' SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION INC.

The Manila Teachers' Savings and Loan Association Inc. (MTSLAI) will hold its 5th Annual Search for Ulirang Guro at Pambansang Ulirang Guro with this year's Theme:

Salamat Titser! Sa Gitna ng pandemya, Ika'y Nagsilbing Pag-asa!

I. Introduction

MANILA TEACHERS' seeks to give honor and special recognition to teachers who have manifested the values of hard work, dedication, sacrifice, commitment and perseverance in order to exemplify that teaching is a vocation not just a profession that can transform lives.

The search aims to single out teachers who have exerted special admirable and herculean efforts in order to teach and educate the Filipino youth. It is not so much about his/her competency but rather the sacrifices and the perils he/she has to face, endure and conquer as a teacher.

MANILA TEACHERS' launched its first ever Search for Pambansang Ulirang Guro in 2016, which later on became an annual event to celebrate our modern day heroes, that is our teachers.

This year's search aims to recognize teachers for their admirable efforts and unwavering dedication to educate Filipinos in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Teachers from public elementary, junior, and senior high schools holding permanent appointment and teaching for the last five years may join the search.

Il Qualifications:

The following are the qualifications of a nominee:

- 1. He/She must be a Filipino citizen;
- 2. He/She must have an average performance rating of Very Satisfactory for the last three years,
- 3. He/She must not be on leave during the period of his/her nomination,
- 4. He/She must be of unquestionable integrity;
- 5. He/She must not have been suspended or sanctioned for violation of administrative policies, rules and regulations;
- 6. He/She must have no pending criminal, civil, or administrative case;

7. He/She must not be a spouse or first-degree relative of an officer or employee of MTSLAI; and

8 He/She must not have been conferred the Outstanding Teacher Award at the National Level for the past five years by any award-giving body (government organizations and non-government organizations).

III. Mechanics:

- 1. The nominee must properly accomplish the nomination form (ANNEX A).
- 2. The nominee must submit to his/her School Principal an essay of at least 500 words, coupled with a 3-minute video on the sacrifices and the perils he/she has faced, endured, and conquered as a teacher and how he/she has improved the lives of his/her pupils/students during the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The submitted nomination form, essay, 3-minute audio-video presentation and other required documents shall be endorsed by the School Principal to the SDS on/before June 30, 2022, who in turn will select the best nominee to endorse to the Regional Director on/or before August 30, 2022.
- 4. The RD shall choose the regional winner and endorse him/her to the National Board of Judges of MTSLAI at Manila Teachers' Savings and Loan Association Head Office, located at 918 United Nations Ave, Manila City on or before September 30, 2022.
- The National Board of Judges shall then choose the 6 finalists from the submitted regional nominees on or before November 15, 2022 to attend the Awarding Ceremony on December 10, 2022 at the venue to be announced.
- 6. At the Awarding Ceremony, the following winners shall be announced:
 - 1 Pambansang Ulirang Guro
 - 3 Ulirang Guro (1 from Luzon, 1 from Visayas, and 1 from Mindanao)
 - 6 Finalists (2 from Luzon, 2 from Visayas, and 2 from Mindanao)

IV. Criteria

Personal Qualities (Model of morality and integrity, good human relations in the school and community)	10%
Exemplification of values and hard work during the Pandemic (Dedication, devotion, sacrifices, hard work, commitment, and perseverance that transformed the lives of the students in the midst of pandemic)	

Professional Development (Self-improvement & professional growth education)	in 10%
Community Development (Active participation in commun services/development and voluntary work during pandemic)	nity 20%

- 1 Pambansang Ulirang Guro will receive the following prizes.
 - a. P 300,000.00 cash
 - b. Plaque of Recognition
 - c, Bouquet/Lei
- 3 Ulirang Guro from each island group will receive the following prizes:
 - a. P 30,000.00 cash
 - b. Plaque of Recognition
 - c. Bouquet/Lei

Two runners-up will receive P 15,000.00 cash, Plaque of Recognition, and Bouquet/Lei.

- 6 Finalists will receive the following prizes:
 - a. P 30,000,00 cash
 - b. Plaque of Recognition
 - c. Bouquet/Lei
- 4 17 Regional Winners will receive the following prizes:
