1. In connection with the **DepEd Order No. 27, s. 2019** titled **Guidelines on the Yearly Collection of Data/Information Requirements and Validation Processes** dated September 20, 2019, this Division shall require all public, private schools and State Colleges and Universities (SUCs) offering elementary, junior and senior high schools to update and upload complete school profile data in the Basic Education Information System for SY 2021-2022.
2. Government Elementary School Profile (GESP), Government Junior High School Profile (GJHSP), Government Senior High School Profile (GSHSP) for Public Schools; Private School Profile (PSP) for private schools; and State Colleges and Universities Profile for SUCs template and user guide are available for downloading at <https://ebeis.deped.gov.ph> using school head account.
3. For integrated schools offering elementary, junior and senior high school a separate school profile shall be uploaded.
4. School Heads and in-charge for validation shall ensure the accuracy and completeness of the school's data while the SGOD - Planning and Research Section personnel shall monitor the on-time online updating.
5. Hard copy of school profile shall be submitted after the online validation to be collated by district for public elementary schools while public secondary, private

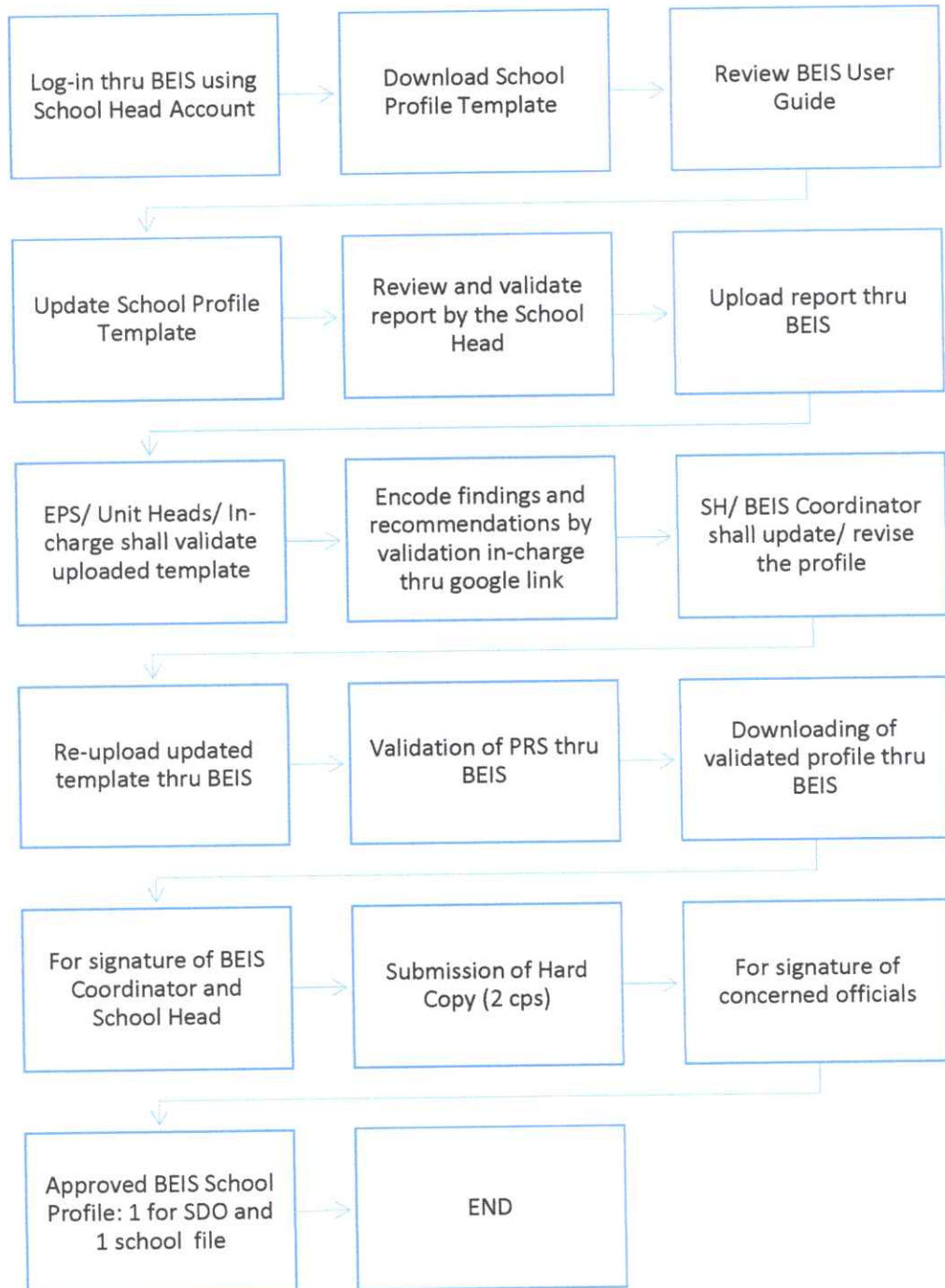
