

Reiteration of the Need to Reactivate the "Brigada Kalinisan Para sa Kalusugan/Aksyon Barangay Kontra Dengue (ABKD) Pagtibayin!"

To avert the anticipated occurrence of a surge of dengue cases in the region, a more cohesive approach to our dengue interventions is needed, hence, we reiterate the need to reactivate and intensify the collaborative strategies and activities of DOH-DepEd-DILG-DSWD for dengue, zika, and chikungunya prevention, as elaborated in the Department Memorandum No. 2015-0348 or "Brigada Kalinisan Para sa Kalusugan/Aksyon Barangay Kontra Dengue (ABKD)" (refer to the enclosed document for guidance).

The reactivation of ABKD shall be conducted prior to the implementation of misting operations if there are observed increasing dengue cases in some communities.

Strengthening Dengue Prevention and Control Through "Brigada Kalinisan Para sa Kalusugan/Aksyon Barangay Kontra Dengue (ABKD)

Pagtibayin!"

The Department of Health, in collaboration with the Department of Education (DepEd), the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG), and the local government units (LGUs) are intensifying their campaign on dengue prevention and control through "Brigada Kalinisan para sa Kalusugan/Aksyon Barangay Kontra Dengue (ABKD)". This is a response to the observed increasing dengue cases in some communities.


Please be advised to jointly undertake the following collaborative actions in your respective regions for a more cohesive approach on our dengue interventions:


- Regional Health Directors shall lead the coordination with DSWD, DepED, and LGUs in prioritizing
 areas and schools with high dengue cases for the planning of dengue information dissemination
 activities, environmental clean-up, and Insecticide-Treated Screen (ITS) installation.
- Regional Health Offices shall provide prototype IEC materials to Regional DepEd during their conduct of school clean up on November 2-8, 2015. These materials are school-appropriate and communityappropriate teaching materials and can be integrated in the school curricula/ teaching syllabi at every level.
- Regional Health Offices in partnership with DepEd Regional Offices shall jointly identify public
 elementary schools for the allocation of ITSs. This is based on the number of dengue cases, vis-a-vis,
 the number of schools at the identified sites. ITS shall be installed in all classrooms at the ground floor
 of every school identified.
- 4. Regional Health Offices in partnership with DSWD Regional Offices shall engage the assistance of parent leaders and selected beneficiaries of 4Ps for actual work on installing/setting up the ITSs. Likewise, the Parent-Teacher Associations (PTAs) of the schools identified can serve as the manpower support to effect the ITS installation and environmental clean-up.
- All Regional Health Directors through their respective Dengue Coordinators shall provide quarterly feedback on the status of this Dengue Program strategy including status of ITS installation, school activities, and community/local actions.
