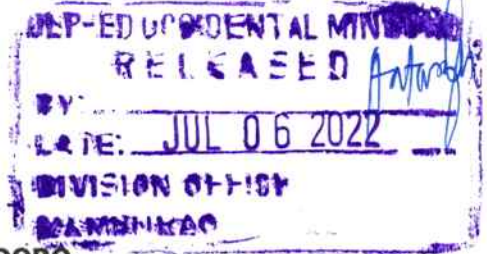

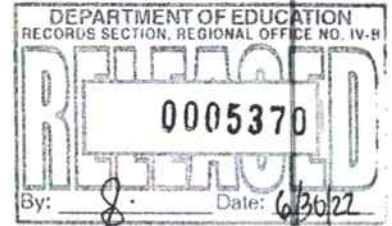

13TH PESPA MIMAROPA REGIONAL TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT

TO: *SCHOOLS DIVISION SUPERINTENDENTS*
HEADS, PUBLIC ELEMENTARY & SECONDARY SCHOOLS

1. The Philippine Elementary School Principals Association (PESPA) MIMAROPA will hold its 13th Regional Principals' Training and Development with the theme **"Strengthening the Passion and Excellence through Revising Work Strategies, Recognizing Challenges, Instilling Positivism towards New Normal Transition,"** from August 2-4, 2022 at Tagaytay Country Hotel, Tagaytay City.
2. The training aims to:
 - a. reskill and upskill school heads to remain competitive and be better prepared for the educational changes;
 - b. promote inclusive education for all;
 - c. enhance effort to conduct professional development opportunities and support services to teachers to become more productive and engage in their work; and
 - d. raise school heads' integrity in the workplace through modeling.
3. The target participants are all public schools district supervisors, principals/head teachers/teachers-in-charge of public and private elementary schools in the Region. Attendance of participants shall be on **Official Business**.
4. A registration fee of **Six Thousand Pesos (Php6,000)** shall be charged to each participant to cover the meals, conference kit, accommodation and honoraria of the resource speakers and other related expenses. All expenses incurred including travel and other incidentals shall be charged to local funds/MOOE, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Arrival and registration of participants will be on August 2, 2022 (Day 1). The first meal to be served will be dinner of Day 1, and the last meal will be lunch of August 4 (Day 3).


