- 1. In support to **Project IMAGE** (Individual Management in Addressing Gaps in Education) of the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), this Office in partnership with the Occidental Mindoro State College (OMSC) will conduct **Training on Computer Systems Servicing (CSS) NC II** on **July 11-14, 2022** (Batch 1), and **July 18-21, 2022** (Batch 2), at the Occidental Mindoro State College San Jose Campus, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro.
- 2. The activity aims to:
- a. enhance technical knowledge, competence, and skills in CSS of EPP/TLE/TVL Teachers;
- b. provide an appropriate learning environment required of the specialization;
- c. increase self-confidence in taking TESDA national assessment;
- d. prepare Public Junior and Senior High Schools with intent to offer CSS as one of their specializations in TLE/TVL.
- 3. This is a LIVE-OUT activity. No registration fee shall be collected. Participants are advised to bring their own food/snacks in the duration of the activity. They are also required to bring school ID for proper identification of the OMSC guard on duty. Training schedule shall be strictly observed which shall start at exactly 8:00 a.m. List of Participants and Training Matrix are found in Enclosures 1 and 2, respectively.

- 4. Participants are required to bring two (2) pieces 1.5 meter UTP Cable and five (5) pcs. RJ45 connector to be used during the hands-on training.
- 5. An institutional assessment shall follow after the training. Passers will then be recommended to TESDA for assessment and certification by the agency.
- 6. Travel and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting, and auditing rules and regulations.
- 7. Minimum health protocols shall be observed and complied with in the whole duration of the activity.
- 8. The teacher-participants shall be entitled to four (4) days service credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53 s. 2003 "Granting of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers".
- 9. Immediate dissemination to all concerned is desired.
