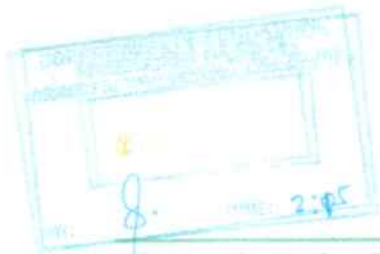


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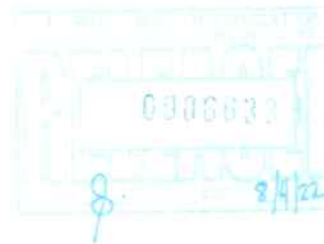

This Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) shall conduct the Live-in Regional Program Implementation Review (PIR) on the Management and Implementation of the Special Program in Technical Vocational Education (SPTVE) at Coron School of Fisheries (CSoF), Bgy. Poblacion 1, Sinamay Coron, Palawan on August 15-16, 2022 (exclusive of travel time).

2. The activity aims to:
- 2.1 gather baseline data, concerns, issues, gaps and challenges in the implementation of the program in light of the Covid 19 pandemic;
 - 2.2 assess the extent of management and implementation of the program and projects/activities conducted in the schools and in the SDO;
 - 2.3 acquaint the 7 SDO EPSs and 8 School Heads of the SPTVE Implementing Schools on the updated information about the program thru the invited BCD and BLD Focal Persons;
 - 2.4 plan/redesign the implementation mechanism of (a) instructional supervision; (b) learning delivery; (c) assessment of learning outcomes (d) curriculum contextualization; and (e) support to the literacy and numeracy initiatives of the schools and SDO.
 - 2.5 benchmark the institutional cooperative in CSoF and the TVL Laboratory of nearby Senior High Schools.

3. Participants to this activity are the 8 Schools Heads of the SPTVE Implementing Schools and the 7 SDO Education Program Supervisor In-charge of EPP/TLE/TVL. The former shall present the school's 3-year accomplishments via Gallery Walk while the latter shall act as observers to walk through the different tarpaulin-display (Banner Tarpaulin size: 2.5' x 6').
