The Bureau of Learner Support Services - School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), in collaboration with Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) through its Regional Fit for School Programme, Hygiene and Behaviour Change Coalition (HBCC), and Stockholm International Water Institute (SIWI) will offer the Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) on **Infection Prevention and Control in Schools** which aims to ensure safe operations within and beyond a pandemic.

COVID-19 pandemic has highlighted the role of health and hygiene measures in schools as part of its pandemic preparedness and response strategy, thereby creating an even greater demand to capacitate school personnel on infection prevention and control (IPC). In response, this MOOC was developed as a capacity-building initiative to reach school personnel at scale and in the most efficient way to ensure that relevant measures related to IPC are reaching school heads and teachers with unified messaging. This is much needed to capacitate respective DepEd personnel on school ground to implement the respective measures in all schools. The content of this IPC MOOC is in accordance with and in support of DepEd Order No. 14, s. 2020 or Guidelines on the Required Health Standards in Basic Education Offices and Schools.

Following are the details of the IPC MOOC:

Course completers will receive a Certificate of Completion signed by DepEd and its international partners, SIWI and GIZ. The IPC MOOC will be offered by cluster: Luzon A, Luzon B, Visayas and Mindanao. Please be guided by the following course schedule:

The course will be under the management of BLSS-SHD with support from GIZ.

All public elementary and secondary schools nationwide are expected to participate in the IPC MOOC. Each school can send at most two (2) representatives. See section I for the qualifications of intended participants.

All Regional Offices, School Division Offices, school heads and teachers are encouraged to support this initiative in order to maintain a safe and healthy learning environment for our learners and the entire school community within and beyond the context of the COVID-19 pandemic.

How to Enroll in the Course

Welcome to the Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) on INFECTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL (IPC) in SCHOOLS. This course aims to help school heads, teachers, and school personnel to better understand the topic of Infection Prevention and Control (IPC) in schools, its relevance to school operations, and the implementation of IPC measures. The course will also explore the connection between Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene in Schools (WinS) and IPC, as part of the Oplan Kalusugan sa DepEd (OK sa DepEd) program. IPC in schools has gained particular relevance in the recent COVID-19 pandemic, which underlined the role of health and hygiene measures.
