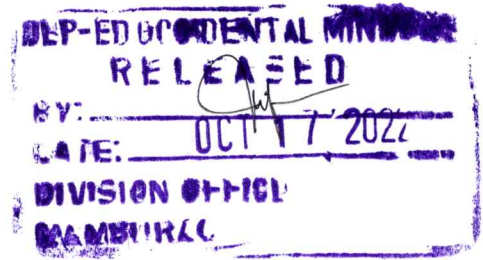



SUBJECT : **DEPED COMPUTERIZATION PROGRAM FY 2022 AND
FY 2023 ALLOCATION AND RECIPIENT SELECTION**

The Department of Education (DepEd) continues to support education delivery and operations by providing information technology equipment to schools through the DepEd Computerization Program (DCP).

Based on the policy direction to return to face-to-face classes, the DCP for fiscal years 2022 and 2023 will provide e-classroom packages for schools. These packages will contain 46 laptops, 1 smart TV, 1 wireless router and 2 charging carts.

In relation to this, all **Schools Division Offices (SDOs) are requested to select the schools that are to receive e-classroom packages** based on the following criteria:

1. The school must have electricity.
2. The school must have not received the DCP package of fifty (50) 2-in-1 tablets or fifty (50) laptops in the past five (5) years (2018 to 2022), unless destroyed by calamities.
3. The school must have at least six (6) sections from Grades 4 to 12.
4. The school must have less than one (1) device (computer or tablet) for every six (6) Grades 4 to 12 learners, regardless of the funding source for the device.

Each SDO must download the spreadsheet template from <https://bit.ly/dcp2022-2023>, submit the editable file and an official transmittal signed by the Schools Division Superintendent to the Regional Office.

Once reviewed by the Regional Office, the Regional Information Technology Officer must consolidate and email the editable spreadsheet files per SDO and an official transmittal signed by the Regional Director with the subject, "DCP FY2022 and FY2023 Allocation List" to the Information and Communications Technology Service (ICTS) at dcp.recipients@deped.gov.ph **on or before 21 October 2022.**
