DESCRIPTION

The Department of Education, Bureau of Curriculum Development, in partnership with the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) and the Center for Health Solutions and Innovations Philippines (CHSI), will host a half-day capacity building activity with the goal to review the basic concepts of CSE and peer education tool, share PeerKADA Challenge updates and experiences, and discuss issues/concerns related to adolescent sexuality and reproductive health. There will be pre-work involved as participants are expected to create their PeerKADA Challenge Report (per region) and prepare for the PeerKADA Breakout ALIVE Sharing activity during the event.
