

Pursuant to DO No. 55, s. 2016 titled, *Policy Guidelines on the National Assessment of Student Learning for the K to 12 Basic Education Program*, this office announces the conduct of the Orientation on the Administration of Early Language Literacy and Numeracy (ELLNA) and National Achievement Test for Grade 6 (NATG6) for SY 2023-2024 on November 28, 2023 at the venue within Mamburao, Occidental Mindoro.
- 2. This activity aims to discuss the guidelines on the administration of ELLNA and NATG6, and the preparation on the conduct of the aforementioned assessment programs.
